Hygienist appointments are a private appointment and have a cancellation fee of £10 per 20 minutes booked*.

*Both are non refundable or charged if less than 24 hours notice is given for whatever reason, or the appointment is missed altogether.

NHS appointments: if you fail to attend, or don't give sufficient notice on two consecutive appointments we may not be able to offer you future appointments.

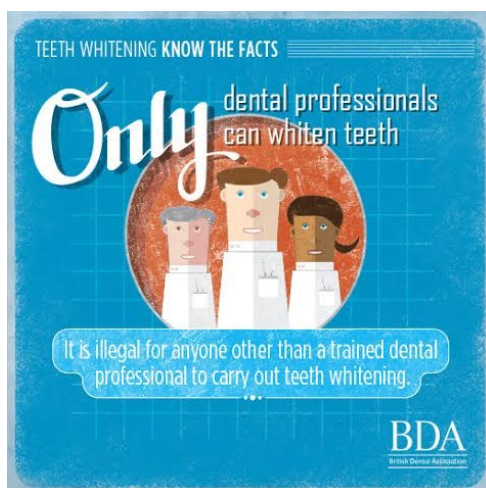

Tuesdays: 08.30 - 17.30

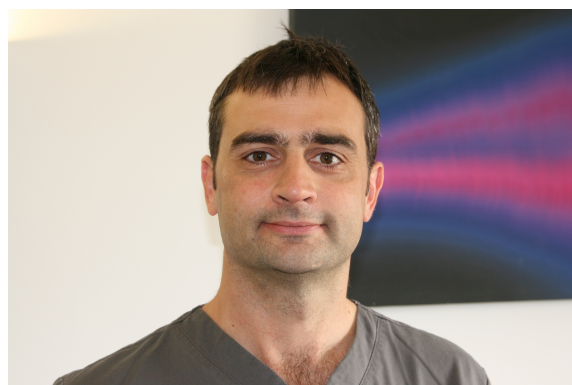

The whole surgical procedure can take place at Passage House Dental Care. There are two parts to an implant. First the Implant. This is placed in the jawbone and acts like the root of the tooth. Second, the replacement crown (top part of tooth that you can see) is fixed onto the implant.
